Fund Provides Relief for F&I Professionals

With the auto industry facing unprecedented losses in the wake of the COVID-19 [pandemic](#), every aspect has been impacted – including F&I professionals, many of whom have experienced layoffs, furloughs or deep cuts in [pay](#).

To help provide support for those affected, more than 40 F&I providers [nationwide](#) have joined together to establish the F&I Providers Relief Fund .

Founded in April, the fund has already raised more than \$500,000 toward its goal of \$1 million to provide grants to F&I professionals faced with financial setbacks as a result of the crisis. Grants are also available to small and/or mid-sized independent dealers who don't have a dedicated F&I manager but are involved in the F&I process.

Contributors to the fund include F&I administrators, underwriters, roadside companies, technology platforms and others involved with dealers and their employees on a day-to-day basis.

“The F&I Providers Relief Fund has brought us together with one goal in mind – to help the people we do business with every day who are now impacted by this crisis,” said Fin O'Neill, chairman and CEO of APCO Holdings, founding partner of the fund and parent company of NIADA National Corporate Partner GWC Warranty.
